Walk-in Interview for Engagement of Guest Faculty

A Walk-in-interview will be held for engagement of Temporary Guest faculties for the 5 year B.A.L.L.B (H) and LL.M (HR) Course at the University Law College, Vani Vihar, Bhubaneswar.

No of Positions for Law Subject: 12 (Twelve)

No of Positions for Social Sciences Subject: 07 (Seven)

The eligible candidates are advised to report at the Conference Hall, University Law College on 11th June 2025 between 08.30 AM to 10.30 A.M. for the walk-in-interview. After 10.30 A.M No candidate shall be entertained for the Walk-in Interview.

Candidates are required to bring

- 1 PP size self attested Photographs.
- All relevant Original Certificates/ Mark sheets (from HSC to Masters Examinations./ NET and Ph.D).
- CV along with 1 set of testimonials duly Xeroxed and self attested for verification.

No T.A., D.A. shall be paid to the applicants to attend the interview. The authority reserves the right to reject and cancel applications of any or all candidates without assigning the reason thereto.

Qualifications:

Age: The age of the candidates shall not exceed 45 years as on the date of the Interview

Educational qualifications:

For Law Subjects: The candidate must have a Master's degree in Law with 55% marks (Or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever the grading system is followed) with UGC NET or Ph.D in Law from any Recognized University. However in case of non availability of UGC NET or Ph.D candidates or found unsuitable by the selection committee, the candidates from other categories having a Master's degree in Law with 55% marks can be considered.

For History, English, Sociology, Public Administration, Political Science and Economics: The candidate must have a Master's degree with 55% marks (Or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever the grading system is followed) in a concerned /relevant/allied subject with UGC NET/ Ph.D in their respective Subjects from any Recognized University.

However, the selection shall be based on the candidate's subject knowledge, Communication Skill, Performance in the demo class and interview.

Tenure of Engagement: The tenure of engagement of Guest faculties shall be purely temporary and valid for a maximum period of one academic session (June 2025 to May 2026). The continuation of engagement will be subject to satisfactory performance, which will be evaluated during the Semester wise review.

Honorarium: Rs. 1000/- Per Class (1 hour duration) subject to maximum 40 Classes for each subject. The Payment will be processed only upon certification of completion of the full course and submission of the relevant Remuneration Bill. No other allowances financial benefits except honorarium shall be allowed in favour of the Guest faculties.

Duties and Responsibilities of the Guest faculty:

- The faculties are required to stay full-time during office hours of the College, if they are assigned more than 80 classes in a semester.
- Required to undertake Academic work like teaching tutorial classes, extra classes, competitive exam classes, conduct of examination, research guidance and any other similar work assignments as per requirement.
- Required to assist in launching extension educational programmes in new and emerging areas, Organize National / International Conferences / seminars / Symposia / Workshop by without any financial commitment from the University Law College.
- Participate in academic/research committees at University law college and elsewhere when required.
- However, they shall not be eligible for holding administrative and financial responsibilities.

Review of Semester wise Performances

The performance of the Guest faculties under this arrangement shall be reviewed semester wise basis by the Principal. If the Classroom teaching performance and official conduct is found unsatisfactory, then he/she may be disengaged forth with by the Principal, ULC, furnishing a report to the Vice-Chancellor of the Utkal University.
